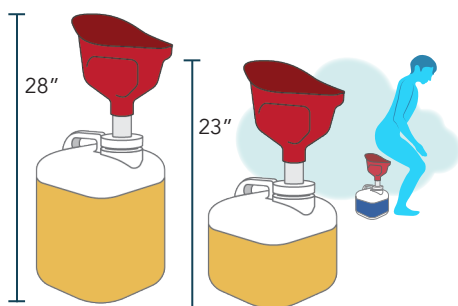

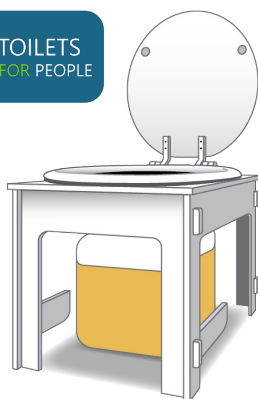
Urine Collector

*Suggested donation: \$45/unit,
additional \$15 for extra jugs*

Odor-blocking funnel attachment with 2.5 or 5 gallon container.

Notes on Sizing:

- People who typically sit to pee may prefer the 2.5 gallon (23 in. height) size.
- People comfortable with standing to pee may prefer the 5 gallon (28 in. height) size.
- Either size can be used in conjunction with a toilet hat or a stand-to-pee device such as the pStyle.

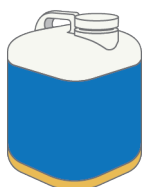


Seated Pee Toilet

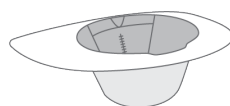

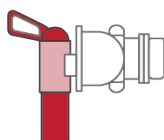
This cloth sleeve serves as a privacy screen for your urine fertilizer container. Made from recycled fabric, these sleeves are sized to fit both 2.5 gallon or 5 gallon collection jugs.



Nun's Cap

Fits into your flush toilet so you can sit to pee. The "cap" has a spout making it easy to pour into your storage container.

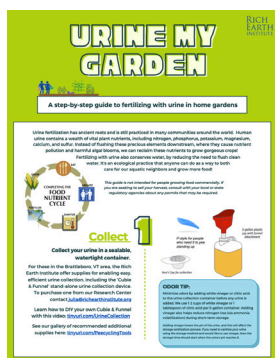

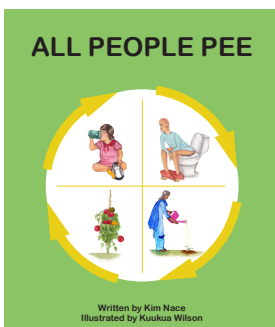
